INSTEAD, A MOTION, WITH THE STYLE OF THE CASE AND CONTAINING A CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE, MUST BE FILED. SIMILARLY, BRIEFS IN LETTER FORM WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. INSTEAD, BRIEFS MUST BEAR THE STYLE OF THE CASE AND CONTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE.
